



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-06

HOLIDAY BOND ORDER

This order replaces any previous order regarding the confinement of any St. Louis County Municipal Court defendants on all County, State, Federal holidays, and days where the court is closed for inclement weather.

- This bond schedule allows the defendant to bond out of custody without the intervention of a judge of the County's Municipal Court.
- No defendant shall be held longer than 48 hours without an order from a St. Louis County Municipal Judge or specified by this order.
- Those released from custody under this order shall be given a return date to court on the first available court date but no more than 2 weeks from the date of release.
- The Duty Judge shall be contacted at 10:00am and 5:30pm if there are defendants in custody that require contact with the judge prior to release per this order.
- The Duty Judge and Court Administrator are available and may be contacted as needed at the numbers listed below for questions or clarification.

| OFFENSE | BOND AMOUNT AND CONDITIONS |

| Minor Traffic Violations and Housing, Zoning, and Nuisance Violations | Release on own recognizance. |
| DWI/DUI/BAC (If there is an accident or death is involved as a result of the alleged charge, the judge must be contacted.) | \$500 Defendant to appear in person. Failure to appear may result in a warrant being issued. No consumption of alcohol prior to operating a MV. Defendant must consent to a breath or blood test upon the request of a LEO |
| Driving While Suspended or Revoked | \$200 Defendant to appear in person. Failure to appear may result in a warrant being issued. Defendant may not drive unless full driving privileges are restored. |
| Drugs (Other than marijuana) and Drug Paraphernalia | \$200 Defendant to appear in person. Failure to appear may result in a warrant being issued. Defendant to not consume or possess any controlled substance. |
| Domestic Assault and all related charges, including Violation of a Protection Order, Destruction of Property, and Trespassing | Duty Judge must be contacted. |
