1. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Marcia Mellitz

2. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

2.1 Summary of Meeting Minutes from December 7, 2021

Motion was made, seconded and agreed to approve the minutes from the December 7, 2021 meeting.

3. NOISE CONTROL SECTION

3.1 Complaint Report for December 2021

No new noise complaints. The only noise complaints we received were from the ongoing issues with AZZ Galvanizing. We did receive additional complaints from the same group of residents. One two days over the month, we received emails from them about the noise. Kyle stated that he took a couple of sound records and on December 20, 2021 they were in violation so they are continuing to make a lot of noise. Denise Scott asked where we were with the County Counselor Office. Kyle stated that Jeremey sent him an update as Jeremey was unable to attend this meeting. The County Counselors Office is expected to make a decision on the type of enforcement action this week. Kathrina stated that they had met with them last week, and they were deciding on how they were

going to move forward. Janice asked who will take the enforcement action. Kathrina stated that the County Counselor's office will take the enforcement against them, she will send an email to the County Counselor assigned to the case to find out if they've made a decision. If she gets any new information she will send an email to the group.

Seven (7) Open Burning Concerns

Open Burning – 11949 Shallowbrook Dr., 63146 (Maryland Heights) - Complaint of open burning located at 11949 Shallowbrook Dr., 63146 (Maryland Heights). At time of site visit no visible fire, smoke, or other evidence of fire. An informational letter with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning – 11149 Schuetz Rd., 63146 (Overland) - Complaint of open burning at 11149 Schuetz Rd., 63146 (Overland). At time of site visit no visible fire, smoke, or other evidence of fire. An informational letter with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning – 4727 Ringer Rd., 63129 (South County) - Complaint of open burning at 4727 Ringer Rd., 63129 (South County). At time of site visit no visible fire, smoke, or other evidence of fire. An informational letter with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning - 201 E Holden, 63125 (Lemay) - Complaint of open burning at 201 E Holden, 63125 (Lemay). At time of site visit evidence of burnt household waste was observed. A Letter of Warning with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. The property did not have trash service. Trash service issue forwarded to the waste management program for enforcement. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning - 602 Weiss Ave., 63125 (Lemay) - Complaint of open burning at 602 Weiss Ave., 63125 (Lemay). At time of site visit no visible fire, smoke, or other evidence of fire. An informational letter with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning - 7501 Cornell Ave., 63130 (University City) - Complaint of open burning at 7501 Cornell Ave., 63130 (University City). At time of site visit no visible fire, smoke, or other evidence of fire. An informational

letter with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

Open Burning - 2655 Denacre Dr., 63129 (South County) - Complaint of open burning at 2655 Denacre Dr., 63129 (South County). At time of site visit a large fire to dispose of leaves was active on this 10 acre property. The fire size and time of day was not compliant with Open Burning Restrictions Ordinance Ch. 612.345. Property owner extinguished fire at time of site visit. A letter or warning with open burning restrictions information has been sent to the property owner. As of January 4, 2022 there have been no additional concerns received for this address.

One (1) Open Burning Concerns

Odor Concern – 1243 Big Bend Crossing Dr., 63088 (Valley Park) – Concern of odor from unknown source located at 1243 Big Bend Crossing Dr., 63088 (Valley Park). Odor was described as chemical odor. Site visit performed. At time of site visit no odor was perceived.

5. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Marcia mentioned that she had been contacted by a St. Louis Post Dispatch reporter regarding the ongoing noise issues with AZZ. Apparently the residents had brought it to the attention of the paper, she stated that she didn't see anything in the paper about it but they could be waiting until they know what the enforcement will be.

Denise stated that she is not currently getting emails from us. She gave her current email address to the group, we will update our records with her current email address to ensure that she will get our emails.
